The In-house program consists of an 8-week season for games. Players require uniforms at additional cost and are reusable in later seasons. Uniforms for In-house teams consist of 1 Maroon and 1 Gold Tee shirt. Shirts are available from club for \$7.00 each. At all In-house SVSC practices and games, shin guards with appropriate covering are required and need to be purchased separately. No jewelry may be worn. While every effort will be made to place a child on their team of choice, it cannot be guaranteed.

The formation of travel teams depends on the number of interested participants, available coaches and, depending on the team, tryouts, and is **not guaranteed**. Participation on a travel team requires an elevated level of player and parent commitment because of the level of competition, more advanced skills, increased formality of rules and requirements (e.g., possibility of forfeit) as well as serving as representatives of the SVSC and our community. The travel coach has the final decision on his/her team player requirements. **The SVSC has final decision on a players travel team placement.** Uniforms are required at an additional cost and are reusable in later seasons. Contact respective travel coach for uniform information. At all SVSC practices and games, shin guards with appropriate covering are required and no jewelry may be worn. **Please note that copies of birth certificates and player photographs are required for new travel players, those players moving up to a new age group or a pass that has been used for 2 seasons. Players "Playing up" 2 or more age groups or U17 and above - i.e. a U14 playing up in U16 require a notarized parent/guardian permission form – No exceptions. Club will perform notary for free.**

Volunteer Information. Volunteers maintain Steel Valley Soccer Club. Organizers and Club Officers needed.

_____ **Fields / Equipment.** Lining of fields, light to medium construction chores and general facilities maintenance. These all require able-bodied volunteer effort. The Club can also benefit from specific skills such as carpentry, welding, electrical or masonry.

_____ **Assistant Coach / Player Development.** The Club will provide training and guidance to any interested parents.
